As a member Practice of South Cotswold Cluster we also participate in the provision of Improved Access appointments via a shared rota. This gives patients an opportunity to book an appointment with General Practice each weekday Monday to Thursday 18.30 - 20.00 hrs, Saturday mornings from 08.30 – 12.30 hrs and at Cirencester Hospital from 14.00 to 20.00 hrs each Friday.

Records are shared across the practices with adherence to strict IT Governance and Confidentiality rules and a signed Information Sharing Agreement has been signed and approved by each practice Named Improved Access Lead and approved by each practice Caldicott Guardian.
